Wastewater Pipeline Rehabilitation Project**

The Town of Longboat Key Public Works Department will be conducting rehabilitation on wastewater pipelines in your area. The wastewater pipelines collect sewage from your neighborhood. Over time, the pipelines develop cracks that allow groundwater to seep in and create issues that increase the cost of treatment and disposal of the treated effluent. The planned work on the pipelines will be done underground without the need to dig up the neighborhood. The Town has contracted with a construction company, Insituform Technologies, to perform the work.

Construction equipment and personnel will be in your neighborhood during normal working hours. The construction will be conducted in several phases beginning this week and continuing through May 2010, weather permitting. The construction crews will only be working in one or two locations at a time. The contractor and Public Works Department will work to provide advanced notification when the work will be done on your individual street. The construction work will not affect your long-term sewer service. A brief interruption to service is possible, but you will be notified ahead of time.

Please use caution when you are driving or walking in close proximity to the construction crews. Barricades and safety cones will be utilized for safety.
