Notice is hereby given that the Mayor of Longboat Key has called a Special Workshop Meeting at 9:00 a.m. on April 15, 2013, in the Commission Chamber located at 501 Bay Isles Road, Longboat Key, Florida, for the purpose of discussing the following item:

1. Meet and Greet with Citizens Interested in Serving on the Firefighters' Retirement System Board of Trustees

The Town and the International Association of Firefighters (IAFF) ratified the Collective Bargaining Agreement which provided for the freezing of the existing Firefighters' pension plan and enrollment of the Plan members in the Florida Retirement System (FRS). The Town Commission will be holding second reading and public hearing of Ordinance 2013-12 which will revise the membership categories for the seated Firefighters' Retirement System Board of Trustees to consist of five Commission appointed residents to the Board and two Town Manager appointments to the Board. The Commission requested that a Special Workshop Meeting be held to provide the opportunity for Town Commissioners to meet the applicants prior to formal appointments at the April 15, 2013, Special Meeting.
