RE : Resolution 2012-19: Comprehensive Plan Amendment - Update to 10-year Potable Water Supply Work Plan

Florida Statutes require that the Town's maintain a potable water supply work plan (work plan), covering at least a ten year planning period, which identifies water supply sources and projects necessary to serve existing and new development. The plan is required to be updated every five years by the regional water authority (Southwest Florida Water Management District aka SWFWMD) and by the Town within eighteen months of the regional update.

The attached Infrastructure Element and supplemental Data and Analysis (D&A) were modified as necessary in order to update the current work plan. The attached documents are presented to the Planning and Zoning Board for recommendation to the Town Commission at this time. All revisions are in legislative format (strike-through/underlined) and highlighted in yellow.

Upon approval by the Town Commission, the amended Infrastructure Element and supplemental D&A will be forwarded for review and comment to the Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), acting as the state land planning agency, and other required regulatory agencies and adjacent governments. Once comments are received, an ordinance for adoption of the work plan will be presented to the Board and to the Commission.
