SUBJECT: Referendum Questions - November 6, 2012 Election Certification

In accordance with the Town Charter, Article II, Section 6, Canvass of returns; certification of election, the Town Clerk is required to forward the results of any election to the Town Commission following certification of the election by each Supervisor of Elections Office. The Town Commission is charged with canvassing the returns and declaring the result of the election for the record.

The results of the two referendum questions that were placed on the November 6, 2012, General Election ballot for consideration by the Town's registered voters, are as follows:

Referendum Question No. 1 (Ordinance 2012-14):

May the Town allow conversion to residential use, with a maximum of six (6) dwelling units per acre, the property located at 5440 Gulf of Mexico Drive (currently zoned C-1, Limited Commercial), comprising approximately 0.76-acres legally described as Lot C-1 of Plat for Cedar Woodlands Subdivision, a replat of Lot 22, Subdivision on Longboat Key, as recorded in Plat Book 7, Page 16, Public Records of Manatee County, Florida

Manatee County:

Yes for approval: 979 votes
No for rejection: 618 votes

Sarasota County:

Yes for approval: 2,020
No for rejection: 941

Total Votes on Referendum Question 1:

Yes for approval: 2,999 votes
No for rejection: 1,559 votes

Referendum Question No. 2 (Ordinance 2012-15):

May the Town allow conversion to residential use, with a maximum residential density not to exceed six (6) dwelling units per acre, for the property located at 521 Broadway Street, currently zoned C-1, Limited Commercial, comprising approximately 0.44-acres.

Manatee County:

Yes for approval: 1,001 votes
No for rejection: 604 votes

Sarasota County:

Yes for approval: 2,038 votes
No for rejection: 927 votes

Total Votes on Referendum Question 2:

Yes for approval: 3,039 votes

No for rejection: 1,531 votes

In accordance with the Certificates of Election Results on file in the Office of the Town Clerk, both referendums were passed by the Town's registered voters.
