



Proposed Ordinance 2013-04, Update of the 10-year Potable Water Supply Work Plan

Planning and Zoning Board

- Florida Statutes require adoption of a potable water supply work plan (Work Plan) as part of its Comprehensive Plan within 18 months of regional water supply plan adoption by Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD).
- On November 5, 2012, Town Commission approved Resolution 2012-19 to transmit proposed Work Plan amendments to state agencies and others for comment.



- Town received one comment, from SWFWMD
- Comment was that regional plan listed reclaimed water and conservation projects by the Town not provided for in the Town's proposed Work Plan.
- Public Works reviewed the projects and determined that the projects were either completed or discontinued.



- Staff discussed the comment and proposed revisions with SWFWMD reviewer.
- Revisions were to the Data & Analysis (D&A) section for the Infrastructure Element.
- SWFWMD reviewer has read and approved the revisions.



- The other substantial revisions were a result of changed circumstances to the Hilton Hotel and Islandside development plans.
- Specific impacts from these development plans were removed from the D&A section.
