Co-location and Shared Use




- Commendation: “The Board and administration have implemented interlocal agreements to reduce costs for services and increase efficiencies.”

- Sarasota Co. Sheriff² = 19




Crossing Guards

 - 3,413 in PSN sites



- Open versus Shared








Interlocal Agreements

Components of a strong ILA might include:


- Shared Liability

- Use Patterns and Priorities


