SUBJECT: Request for Temporary Closure of Bay Isles Road and Use of Town Hall Facility for Chamber of Commerce 2013 Freedom Fest Event Between the Hours of 8:30 and 11:30 AM

The Longboat Key Chamber of Commerce organizes a community celebration for the Fourth of July each year in Bicentennial Park and along Bay Isles Road. The event features a brief parade, food, music, children's games, and activities.

The Chamber requests Town Commission consideration for the temporary closure of Bay Isles Road between the hours of 8:30 and 11:30 AM for this year's event to allow for the parade and for safety of the participants during the event. (See attached 6-3-13 letter.)

Town Code provisions require Town Commission authorization for temporary road closures.

This request is recommended to be placed on the June 17, 2013 Regular Workshop Meeting for consideration and the following Special Meeting for approval.

In previous years the Town has assisted during this event by providing staffing and minor equipment. The costs to the Town associated with this event are approximately \$1,100.

Staff recommends the Town's continued support of this event.
