SUBJECT: Request for Temporary Closure of Various Roadways within the Village for a Holiday Parade on December 14, 2013 Between the Hours of 3:30 P.M. and 4:15 P.M.

The Town has received a request from Mr. Michael Drake requesting authorization to utilize various roadways and street right-of-way for a Holiday Parade within the Village area, as follows:

- staging on Palm Street
- commence parade on Broadway proceeding to Longboat Drive North, Longboat Court, Longboat Drive East, Russell Street, and Bayside Drive
- concluding at Moore's Restaurant.

Mr. Drake requests Town Commission consideration for the temporary closure of the roadways between the hours of 3:30 p.m. and approximately 4:15 p.m. for this event to allow for the parade and for safety of the participants during the event. (See attached correspondence dated December 2, 2013.)

Town Code provisions require Town Commission authorization for temporary road closures. Mr. Drake is in the process of securing a Public Forums Permit as required by the Town Code and has advised that there are no costs to the Town associated with the event. The roadways identified by Mr. Drake include Broadway Street, Longboat Drive North, Longboat Court, Longboat Drive East, Russell Street, and Bayside Drive

This request is placed on the December 11, 2013, Special Meeting for formal action.


