SUBJECT: Appointment to Town Boards and Committees

A. Planning and Zoning (P&Z) Board

There are three terms expiring on May 14, 2014, as per the attached Membership Roster. The following individuals have submitted applications for consideration to serve on the Planning and Zoning Board:


Planning & Zoning Board Membership Roster

The Planning & Zoning Board shall consist of nine members appointed by the Town Commission. All members must be registered voters and residents of the Town of Longboat Key. No member shall be an elected official or employee of the town. All members must attend a sunshine and public records law class within three months of their appointment (Ord. 2010-09).

All terms of appointment shall be for a period of three years. The term of appointment shall expire on the second Wednesday of May of the year in which the term is set to expire. Vacancies shall be filled by appointments for the unexpired term.

Zoning Board of Adjustment Membership Roster


Town Code Reference: 158.026 Zoning Board of Adjustment

The ZBA shall consist of seven members appointed by the Town Commission. All members must be registered voters and residents of the Town of Longboat Key. No member shall be an elected official or employee of the town.

All terms of appointment shall be for a period of three years and shall expire on the second Wednesday in May of the year in which the term is set to expire. Appointments to fill any vacancy on the zoning Board of Adjustment shall be for the unexpired term of the member whose term becomes vacant. All members must attend a sunshine and public records law class within three months of their appointment (Ord. 2010-09).

The Zoning Board of Adjustment shall establish rules and regulations for its own operation not inconsistent with the provisions of applicable state statutes or of this chapter.

Code Enforcement Board Membership Roster

Town Code Reference: 33.03 Establishment; members

The CEB shall consist of seven members appointed by the Town Commission. All members must be registered voters and residents of the Town of Longboat Key. The Code Enforcement Board shall, whenever possible, consist of persons experienced in their respective fields as follows: 1) Architect; 2) Businessman; 3) Engineer; 4) General Contractor; 5) Subcontractor; 6) Realtor.

No member shall be an elected official or employee of the town.

All terms of appointment shall be for a period of three years and shall expire on the second Wednesday in May of the year in which the term is set to expire. Appointments to fill any vacancy on the Code Enforcement Board shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term of office. Any member who fails to attend three consecutive scheduled and called regular meetings shall automatically forfeit his appointment, and the Town Commission shall promptly fill the vacancy.


Tasks

The Sarasota County Commissioners thru adoption of Sarasota County Ordinance 2007-87 continuing this Board through December 31, 2024. (4 year appointments)



Firefighters' Retirement System Board of Trustees

Section 34.45 - Board of Trustees - The sole and exclusive administration of and responsibility for the proper operation of the system and for making effective the provisions of sections 34.43 through 34.67 are hereby vested in a board of trustees. The board is hereby designated as the plan administrator. The board shall consist of seven trustees, five of whom, unless otherwise prohibited by law, shall be legal residents of the town, who shall be appointed by the Longboat Key Town Commission, and two of whom shall be appointed by the Town Manager. The Longboat Key Town Commission shall designate one of the trustees it appoints as chairman of the board and another trustee as vice chairman and may change such designations from time to time. Each resident trustee shall serve as trustee for a period of one year, unless he sooner vacates the office or is sooner replaced by the Longboat Key Town Commission at whose pleasure he shall serve. Each trustee appointed by the Town Manager shall serve as trustee for a period of two years, unless he sooner vacates the office or is sooner replaced by the Town Manager at whose pleasure he shall serve. Each trustee may succeed himself in office. The board shall meet at least quarterly each year. The board shall be a legal entity with, in addition to other powers and responsibilities contained herein, the power to bring and defend lawsuits of every kind, nature, and description. The trustees shall, by a majority vote, elect a secretary. The secretary of the board shall keep a complete minute book of the actions, proceedings, or hearings of the board. The trustees shall not receive any compensation as such, but may receive expenses and per diem as provided by law.



General Employees' Retirement System Board of Trustees

Town Code Reference: Section 34.75 - The sole and exclusive administration of and responsibility for the proper operation of the system and for making effective the provisions of the ordinance from which this subchapter derives are hereby vested in a board of trustees. The board is hereby designated as the plan administrator. The board shall consist of seven trustees, five of whom, unless otherwise prohibited by law, must be registered voters and residents of the town, who shall be appointed by the Longboat Key Town Commission, and two of whom shall be appointed by the Town Manager. The Longboat Key Town Commission shall designate one of the trustees it appoints as chairman of the board and another trustee as vice chairman and may change such designations from time to time. Each resident trustee shall serve as trustee for a period of one year, unless he sooner vacates the office or is sooner replaced by the Longboat Key Town Commission at whose pleasure he shall serve. Each trustee appointed by the Town Manager shall serve as trustee for a period of one year, unless he sooner vacates the office or is sooner replaced by the Town Manager at whose pleasure he shall serve. Each trustee may succeed himself in office. All trustees must attend a sunshine and public records law class within three months of their appointment. The board shall meet at least quarterly each year. The board shall be a legal entity with, in addition to other powers and responsibilities contained herein, the power to bring and defend lawsuits of every kind, nature and description. No trustee shall be an elected official. A person appointed to this board may not serve concurrently on any of the following town boards: Code Enforcement Board, Planning and Zoning Board, or Zoning Board of Adjustment.
