



## **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO REGISTERED VOTERS**

All Longboat Key registered voters should have received their May 12, 2015, ballot for a Special Election with regard to the following referendum question:

May the Town allow up to 300 new tourism units with tourism and accessory uses within certain portions of the Longboat Key Club Lowercase property located at 201 and 301 Gulf of Mexico Drive and 361 Longboat Club Road and situated within the MUC-2 land use category and zoning district provided such allowance shall not exceed the maximum allowable overall MUC-2 density?

*Please be advised that this referendum does not guarantee approval of a development for the subject property or for a specific development plan. Additional approvals for any development must be obtained from the Town of Longboat Key prior to development of the property.*

**THIS ELECTION IS BEING CONDUCTED BY MAIL BALLOT. THERE WILL BE NO PRECINCTS OPEN ON MAY 12, 2015. YOUR BALLOT MUST BE MAILED, IN THE STAMPED ENVELOPE INCLUDED WITH YOUR BALLOT TO THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS OFFICE AND RECEIVED PRIOR TO 7:00 P.M. ON MAY 12, 2015.**

If you **HAVE NOT** received your mail ballot, or it has been spoiled (marked incorrectly), you **may request** a “Replacement Ballot” by **May 6, 2015 (if mailed)**, by **completing, signing, and submitting** a “Sworn Statement for Replacement Ballot” to the Supervisor of Elections in person, by mail, by fax, or scanned and attached to an email.
