The State of Florida Beach Management Funding Assistance Program (formerly the Beach Erosion Control Program) may be a recurring source of funding for the Town's beach nourishment projects related to the Town's comprehensive inlet management plan. The Longboat Pass Maintenance Dredging and Beneficial Sediment Use Project is consistent with the Town's plan. This is the second year the Town Commission is being requested to pass a funding resolution to accompany its Local Government Funding Request application for State grants.

Each funding request requires a resolution from the local agency in support of and confirming the Town's ability to fund each project. An Interlocal Agreement with Manatee County regarding the maintenance of Longboat Pass includes a provision to share sand placement, alternating between Anna Maria Island adjacent beaches and Longboat Key.

Proposed Resolution 2015-15 is recommended to be submitted to FDEP for the sole purpose of funding work that the Town of Longboat Key may have to perform relative to the Longboat Pass Inlet. Inlet reimbursement funding percentages are typically higher than the general beach funding reimbursement.

RESOLUTION 2015-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF LONGBOAT KEY, FLORIDA, REQUESTING APPROVAL BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION OF A TOWN APPLICATION FOR FUNDS FOR A LONGBOAT PASS MAINTENANCE DREDGING AND BENEFICIAL SEDIMENT USE PROJECT AS PROVIDED UNDER CHAPTER 161, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Longboat Key supports a comprehensive inlet management plan at Longboat Pass to protect and preserve this valuable infrastructure, and adjacent environmental habitat; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Longboat Key in cooperation with Manatee County developed the Longboat Pass Inlet Management Plan Study; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Longboat Key seeks to memorialize its support of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's (FDEP) inlet management programs through design and engineering studies, environmental studies and monitoring, inlet management planning and activities to manage adjacent beach erosion due to inlet dynamics on Longboat Key and Anna Maria Island to the North, and other such state and local activities that are consistent with the State's Strategic Beach Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Longboat Key seeks to memorialize and confirm its support of the necessary inlet and adjacent Town beach maintenance programs provided for in the Inlet Management Plan Study, that the Town will serve as local sponsor, and that the Town has the ability to fund the local share to implement its maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LONGBOAT KEY, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The above Whereas clauses are hereby incorporated, ratified and confirmed as true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Beaches and Coastal Systems, is hereby requested to approve the Town's Funding Application for the purpose of maintaining Longboat Pass and the Town's affected beaches as recommended by its Longboat Pass Inlet Management Plan Study.

SECTION 3. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Beaches and Coastal Systems, is hereby requested to approve the Town's Funding Application for the purpose of implementing the Longboat Pass Maintenance Dredging and Beneficial Sediment Use Project.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
