Consistent with the Town's Joint Inlet Management Plan with Manatee County, an annual funding request is submitted to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. This resolution is an application requirement that confirms the funding ability of the Town. Proposed Resolution 2016-13 provides for the Town to be jointly eligible along with Manatee County for State funding assistance.

The Town submits an annual cost-share funding request for this program. Each funding request requires a resolution from the local agency in support of and confirming the Town's ability to fund each project.

Proposed Resolution 2016-xx is our general resolution for cost sharing funds for work the Town may undertake in the future relative to design, permitting and construction of sand placement projects as well as other structures. Typically, these costs are shared with the State on a 22.79% basis.

RESOLUTION 2016-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF LONGBOAT KEY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN TO FILE A LOCAL LONG-RANGE BUDGET PLAN FOR INLET MANAGEMENT, IN SUPPORT OF BEACH MANAGEMENT, WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION; SUPPORTING THE PROJECTS FOR WHICH FUNDING IS REQUESTED; CONFIRMING THE TOWN'S ABILITY TO SERVE AS JOINT LOCAL SPONSOR FOR THE PROJECT AND THE ABILITY TO FUND THE APPROPRIATE JOINT LOCAL SHARE OF THE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Public Works projects and studies relating to Inlet and Pass Management are eligible for State funding consideration under the provisions of Chapter 628-36 of the Florida Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, in order to qualify for State of Florida beach project funding, State of Florida policy requires submission of a local long-range Inlet and Pass Management Plan by the government entity which coordinates the Town's coastal management program; and

WHEREAS, management and maintenance dredging of Longboat Pass, located between Anna Maria Island and the Town of Longboat Key, is planned to be conducted by Manatee County and the Town of Longboat Key as joint local project sponsors, with subsequent reimbursement of the State share of the eligible costs; and

WHEREAS, the Longboat Key Town Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to pursue all available funding in order to manage and maintain Longboat Pass in Manatee County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF LONGBOAT KEY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The above Whereas clauses are hereby incorporated, ratified and confirmed as true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Town of Longboat Key is authorized and directed to file a joint Local Long-Range Budget Plan with Manatee County for Inlet Management in support of beach management with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

SECTION 3. The Longboat Key Town Commission supports Inlet Pass Management projects for which funding is requested from the State of Florida.

SECTION 4. The Town of Longboat Key is able to serve as the joint local sponsor for the project and is able to provide the appropriate local funding share to implement Longboat Pass maintenance.

SECTION 5.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
