### Background

At each Town Commission meeting the Town Manager provides a review of the latest information related to COVID-19 on Longboat Key.

There are no changes to the Town's operations since the March 22, 2021 Emergency Meeting update to the Commission. All facilities are open with restrictions. Each request for use of Town property for events are reviewed for appropriate CDC and COVID-19 safety measures, on a case-by-case basis. We continue to urge individuals doing business with the Town to utilize our virtual customer service via e-mail, website, and phone for their own safety as well as the safety of Town staff.

The Town's Emergency Mask Ordinance passed at a Town Commission Emergency Special Meeting on March 22, 2021, remains in effect until May 21, 2021.

We continue to monitor the current trend in positives following Phase 3 re-openings, Spring Break, and the increasing numbers of seasonal visitors to the island. As of Wednesday, April 14, 2021 the State Dashboard is reporting 256 cumulative cases for Longboat Key's 34228 zip code. This is an increase of 10 cases since my update for the April 5, 2021 Regular Meeting.

We will present up-to-date information from the Florida Department of Health regarding local positive cases, and testing. We will also will discuss the status of vaccine distribution as it relates to Longboat Key residents, new eligibility criteria for registering for the vaccine, and expanding vaccine sites by Federal, State, County and retail locations.
