- B. Resolution 2021-10, Adopting the Town of Longboat Key FY 2021-2022 (FY22) Budget

Resolution 2021-10 provides for an adopted budget of the Town of Longboat Key FY22 Budget, and provides for compliance with the Capital Improvements element of the Town’s Comprehensive Plan.

Recommended Action: Pass Resolution 2021-10.

5. Ordinance – First Reading and Public Hearing

Ordinance 2021-05, Amending the Capital Improvements Schedule of the Capital Improvements Element Concurrent with Adoption of the FY 2021-2022 (FY22) Budget.

Ordinance 2021-05 concurrently updates the five-year Capital Improvement Schedule of the Capital Improvements Element with adoption on the FY22 Budget as required by Florida Statutes.

Recommended Action: Adopt Ordinance 2021-05.
