Welcome to our new Vice Mayor Maureen Merrigan, and Ken Schneier reappointed Mayor for another year!

The 2022 Citizens Survey - thanks to all that responded!!! Sneak preview shows 99% of respondents indicate they are happy with the Quality of Life on Longboat Key and 90% are satisfied with Customer Service by Town Staff - high numbers and great feedback. Congrats to the employees for continuing to recognizing the importance of customer service. Top priorities identified for the Town: Beach Management, Infrastructure Update, Traffic Congestion and Fiscal Sustainability. Overall results to be presented at the April 4<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting.

Strategic Planning- April includes the Town Commission Goals & Objectives Workshop, Commissioner's Strategic Planning and setting Top Priorities for 2022-2023. These meetings help Commissioners hear from the public on various community issues and interests tied to the Town's Vision Plan. Then Commissioners use their Annual Retreat to prioritize initiatives which guides staff in development of the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget.

This workshop is in partnership with Sarasota County, and will cover the basics of how the various types of EVs work, considerations for those interested in buying an EV (including calculating return on investment), local charging infrastructure, and the benefits these cars provide.

**Greer Island Spit Management** – Town staff is waiting for final project permits from the Army Corps of Engineers. We are eager to begin work to remove the spit and opening up lagoon access and increased tidal flow in the area.
