Subject: Resolution 2022-13, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement with the Town of Longboat Key

Recommended Action

Pass Resolution 2022-13.

Background

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has jurisdiction over and maintains SR 789 (Gulf of Mexico Drive) as part of the State Highway System.

The Town and FDOT share a Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement (ARW13) for the traffic signals along Gulf of Mexico Drive. The Town is agreeable to maintaining traffic signals along Gulf of Mexico Drive with FDOT compensating the Town for such maintenance.

The FDOT has presented an Amendment to the Agreement with a revised Exhibit A reflective of the total lump sum for compensation to the Town for Fiscal Year 2023. The FY 2023 State compensation to the Town totals \$14,572. The previous year total was \$14,194.

Resolution 2022-13 authorizes and memorializes the Town's agreement to maintain the traffic signals on Gulf of Mexico Drive under Agreement ARW13, and authorizes the Town Manager to execute the associated agreement(s) and future amendments with FDOT as needed.
