Background

The Town hired Kimley Horn and Associates, as a consultant to conduct stormwater and drainage assessments for the Buttonwood Harbour and Sleepy Lagoon areas, respectively. Town staff and the consultant held public meetings with each neighborhood on April 20, 2022. These were to provide informational updates and progress of the assessment efforts as well as to encourage the communities to participate and provide valuable feedback.

Kimley Horn has since reviewed and compiled that feedback and will present an update as to the stormwater and drainage assessment for Buttonwood Harbour and Sleepy Lagoon at the June 20, 2022, Town Commission Regular Workshop Meeting.

This is an interim update on the assessments. The consultant will continue compiling comments from the residents and refining potential neighborhood public improvement projects.

Kimley Horn will be developing a final report that will provide conceptual level solutions, a summary report, and planning cost estimates for public improvements that are recommended. It is expected that those recommendations and the final report will be completed by September.

The Commission previously identified a portion of the Town's ARPA funds to be used to help implement recommendations. Once the final report and cost estimates are available, the staff will develop a project plan based on available funding.
