Town Initiatives – Snapshot

Red Tide has been reported in our area and for the first time this year we've begun seeing some accumulation on our beaches, and within Sarasota Bay. Typically dead fish accumulation washes out with the next tidal cycle. In the event accumulations reach our threshold for pick-up staff will coordinate clean up efforts. Legislative Session kicks off on Wednesday, March 8. The Commission and staff are sharing with our Legislative Delegation the Town's legislative priorities and issues of concern to us locally, regionally and at the State level. Save the Water Drops – Green Workshop on March 28 from 10-11am. Join us at Town Hall for this presentation by Jackie Lebouitz, Water Resources Program Assistant UF/IFAS Extension Sarasota County. Learn where our potable water comes from, the future of Florida's supply, and what steps we can take to conserve it. You'll leave with information on leak detection tips, water-efficient appliances, and other devices, and simple ways to reduce your use at home by changing your habits.

Utilities Undergrounding Project. All underground electrical infrastructure is in place. Individual property conversions are underway in Phase 2 (North end of the island) and is expected to continue for Phases 3 & 4 into Spring 2023 followed by final FPL removal of poles and aerial wires.

Gulfstream & U.S. 41 Roundabout Project is open, *but still not complete.* Check traffic congestion before you leave for the mainland and plan your commute time accordingly.
