A. Resolution 2024-10, Setting of Millage Rate for the Town's General Operating, General Obligation Debt Service, Gulfside District, and Bayside District

Second reading and public hearing to consider Resolution 2024-10 to provide for millage rates for Longboat Key's General Operating fund, General Obligation Debt Service, Gulfside District, and Bayside District.

Recommended Action: Following public hearing, pass Resolution 2024-10.

B. Resolution 2024-16, Adopting the Town of Longboat Key FY 2024-2025 (FY25) Budget

Second reading and public hearing to consider Resolution 2024-16 to provide for a tentatively adopted FY25 Budget of the Town of Longboat Key and the FY25-FY29 Capital Improvement Plan to provide for compliance with the Capital Improvements element of the Town's Comprehensive Plan.

Recommended Action: Following public hearing, pass Resolution 2024-16.

C. Ordinance 2024-08, Amending the Capital Improvements Schedule of the Capital Improvements Element

Second reading and public hearing to consider Ordinance 2024-08 to concurrently update the five-year Capital Improvement Schedule of the Capital Improvements Element with adoption on the FY25 Budget as required by Florida Statutes.

Recommended Action: Following public hearing, adopt Ordinance 2024-08.
