2. Ordinance 2019-17, Amendment to Chapter 92, Parks, Public Beaches, and Public Beach Accesses; Amending Ordinance 2014-29; Amending the Town of Longboat Key Code of Ordinances Section 92.62 Geographic Boundary of Bayside District The Town Code provides for two dependent special districts within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Town known as the Longboat Key Gulfside District and Longboat Key Bayside District. These special districts provide for ad valorem tax levies for beach projects imposed via bond referenda. The Manatee County Property Appraiser has recommended amending the legal description of the Bayside District, geographic boundary description text to include the islands within the Town's jurisdiction, specifically, Sister Keys. Ordinance 2019-17 is placed on the November 20, 2019 Special Meeting for first reading and public hearing. Recommended Action: Forward Ordinance 2019-17 to the December 2, 2019 Regular Meeting for second reading and public hearing.
